Parks

Settler's Park – Community Park

11250 5th Street NE

Located north of the Hanover City Hall and adjacent to the Hanover Athletics' Association Complex. Settler's Park itself consists of 4.99 acres. The shelter area is available to rent for events from the City.

Amenities:

- Sheltered picnic area with kitchen and restrooms
- Picnic tables with outdoor grills
- Small T-ball field (unfenced)
- Large little league baseball field (fenced)
- Horseshoe pits
- Sand volleyball court
- Drinking fountain
- Bike rack
- Playground equipment with a large sand filled play area
- Large paved parking lot with drive up access to shelter

Eagle View Park – Neighborhood Park

53 Jansen Avenue NE

Located on the southern side of the Hanover Hills Development overlooking the Crow River. Eagle View Park consists of approximately 3.68 acres. In addition to the playground equipment and the 16' gazebo, this park offers a popular sliding hill during the winter months.

Amenities:

- Playground equipment with play area
- 16' gazebo
- Picnic table and bench rest areas
- Grill
- Portable restroom (ADA compliant)
- Sliding hill
- Small (8 car) paved lit parking lot

Pheasant Run Park – Neighborhood Park

710 Meander Road NE

Located in the Pheasant Run neighborhood east of downtown Hanover. Pheasant Run Park consists of 2.01 acres. This park has several outdoor grills and gazebo sitting areas which makes it a nice location to picnic for small to medium sized groups.

Amenities:

- Playground equipment
- Basketball hoop on concrete
- Several outdoor charcoal grills
- Gazebo shelters (2)
- Picnic tables and tree shaded lawn
- Drinking fountain
- Portable restroom (ADA compliant)
- Bike rack
- Small (12 car) unpaved parking lot
- Horseshoe pit

Cardinal Circle Park– Neighborhood Park

631 Kadler Circle

Located in the Crow River Heights neighborhood northwest of downtown Hanover. Cardinal Circle Park consists of 5 acres.

Amenities:

- Playground equipment
- Softball field
- Soccer field
- Portable restroom (ADA compliant)
- Grass play area for multi-use recreation field
- Shelter structure is included in the plans for a 2012 project

Mallards' Landing Park – Neighborhood Park

1033 Mallard Street NE

Located in the Schendel's Field neighborhood northeast of downtown Hanover. Mallards' Landing Park is slightly smaller than 2 acres.

Amenities:

- Playground equipment
- Soccer field
- Basketball court
- Gazebo
- Picnic table
- Portable restroom (ADA compliant)

Bridgeview Park – Neighborhood Park

10510 – 107th Avenue N

Located in the Bridges at Hanover neighborhood southwest of downtown Hanover. Bridgeview Park is located on land owned by the Bridges at Hanover homeowners association that is lease to the City.

Amenities:

- Playground equipment

Historical Bridge Area

Located on the south side of the historic bridge adjacent to the Crow River. The area will have trail access in the future and will be primarily used for a sitting and resting area. The Hanover Bridge was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1979. The historical bridge is a pedestrian bridge that crosses the Crow River and separates Hennepin County and Wright County.

Riverside Park – Wright County

Riverside County Park is a small regional park located in the northeast quadrant of Hanover. The park is maintained by the Wright County Parks Department, consists of 17 acres with ¼ mile of river frontage, a picnic area, a canoe and camping site with toilets.

Crow-Hassan Park Reserve – Hennepin County

Crow-Hassan Park Reserve is a regional park reserve located along the eastern boundary of the City of Hanover. The park is maintained by Hennepin County Parks Department, consists of 2,600 acres and offices nature-oriented outdoor recreation.
