New Interim Use Permit

The City has received an application from Fehn Companies for a new Interim Use Permit (IUP) that includes an expanded mining area.

Fehn Companies (or an associated entity) are in the process of acquiring additional properties adjacent to the existing mine site. This acquisition and proposed new IUP would expand their mining area up to 155 acres. No mining excavation or stockpiling of materials is proposed on portions of the acquired properties that are located in either the floodplain or shoreland area. The bottom of the mine surface is proposed to be at least 10 feet above the ground water level.
