Compost-Brush Site Access Card Request Form

The City of Hanover is issuing the property owner an access card to the City of St. Michael's compost-brush site located at 3150 Lander Ave NE. This site is available for Hanover residents, and **no contractors** will be allowed use of the site.

By signing below, you acknowledge the following:

- I live at the property as stated below.
- I understand that if the access card is lost, I must advise the City immediately and payment of \$5.00 is required in order to obtain a new card. If the lost card should be found, the City will not reimburse the replacement card fee since that card will have been deactivated.
- If I move, the access card should be returned to the City, or left for the new homeowner/renter.

Violation of any of the following will result in the loss of access to the compost-brush site:

- As a Hanover resident, I will not give out the access card for non-residents to gain access to the City of St. Michael's compost-brush site.
- I understand that the compost-brush site is under 24 hour recorded surveillance. Any illegal disposing of items not listed at the site entrance will be reported to the Wright County Sheriff's Department to issue a citation and the loss of access to the compost site.
- I understand that I **cannot** dispose of pallets, tree stumps, landscape timbers, lumber or construction debris of any kind, or household garbage at the site.
- I understand that grass clippings and leaves must be removed from bags and the bags disposed of properly off-site.
