



The City of Hanover has a curbside single sort recycling program through Randy's Environmental Services. The benefit of single sort recycling is no more sorting! As more and more items are being made to be recycled, recycling carts should be full. Every other Thursday, residents need to have their recycling at the curb by 7 am.

**Materials collected for recycling:**

- Boxboard (ie: cereal, cracker, shoe boxes) and Cardboard
- Mixed mail and office paper
- Newspapers and magazines
- Aluminum beverage cans
- Metal food cans
- Glass bottles and jars (all colors)
- Plastic containers and lids (numbers 1-7) such as pop and juice bottles, milk jugs and water bottles
- Aseptic and gable-topped containers such as juice and milk cartons and juice boxes



**Don't put these materials in the recycling cart:**

- No plastic bags
- No egg cartons
- No Styrofoam
- No pizza boxes
- No window glass
- No mirror or plate glass
- No ceramic or porcelain
- No toys, dishes, hangers
- No motor oil jugs
- No metal car parts
- No flower pots
- No plastic or metal household items
